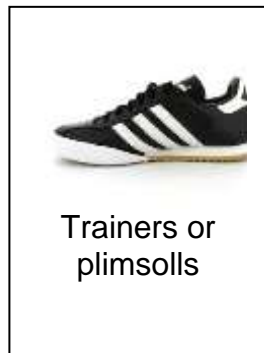
Shapla Physical Activity Policy Information for parents



PE Kit:

Children from Year 1 to Year 6 must change into a PE kit when they participate in sports activities. This is for hygiene and Health and Safety reasons. Children are not allowed to wear headscarves, earrings or other jewellery during PE for health and safety reasons.

Swimming:

The Department for Education says that 'All schools must provide swimming instruction either in key stage 1 or key stage 2.'

This is a legal requirement, therefore all children must participate in swimming.

If children are well enough to attend school they will be expected to go swimming, unless they have a written note from the doctor saying that they must not swim. It is parent's responsibility to provide this for the school office. If we have a concern about attendance and children missing swimming we will refer children to the School Nurse and the Attendance and Welfare Advisor.
